Last month several CSHA paraders participated in the 100th annual California Rodeo at Salinas. The weather was absolutely perfect and spectators lined the streets on the four and one half mile long parade route. Pamela Michalek, the GiddyUp Gals, and myself enjoyed the ride which crossed over Freeway 101 to the rodeo grounds for the Grand Entry. Also appearing were our new novelty fiesta mounted group members led by Patricia Macugay of Wheatland.

The July Quarterly meeting did not have a quorum. Hopefully, you can come to the September 18th meeting in Santa Nella so we can vote on the location of the State Championship Parade to be held after January 2011. It is not too late to submit your host city choice for this special annual event to honor our members.

Kassi Gutierrez submitted her report for the 2009 State Championship Parade that was held May 1, 2010 in Los Banos. The budget was started with \$1170.00 in nomination fees from the 2009 year. We had cash donations in the amount of \$990.00 and raffle tickets sold in the amount of \$220.00. Auction item (hay) \$100., sale of parade pins \$45.00, and dinner tickets sold \$1148.00 which was the exact cost of the dinner at Espanas' Restaurant. The high point awards totaled \$1531.63, which left a deficit of \$361.63. The Championship awards cost \$170.00 and were donated. The cost of the high point buckle was \$127.66. Printing and engraving of replacement perpetual awards amounted to \$150.84. Our balance left was \$714.87.

September through December are very busy months for parading. Please do not forget to enter the parades of your choice in a timely manner. Also, please remember that you must be prejudged before each parade in order to receive points. The CSHA rule book also states that you are penalized five points for being late for prejudging.

May the remaining part of Summer be a wonderful time for all of us. I am looking forward to seeing you soon at a parade.
