

Class List and Description

1. **OPEN:** Open to all riders. \$25
2. **LIMITED OPEN:** Open to all riders who have not earned \$7,500 in Reining.
3. **ROOKIE PROFESSIONAL:** Open to any rider except those holding a NRHA Non-Pro, Youth or Youth Non-Pro card or an amateur card from CSHA or other National Breed Association. Rider must not have earned more than \$5,000 in lifetime earnings. \$25
4. **NOVICE HORSE OPEN – LEVEL 1:** Open to all riders. Horses must not have earned more than \$5,000 in Reining. Class 4 runs concurrent with class 5. \$25
5. **NOVICE HORSE OPEN – LEVEL 2:** Open to all riders. Horses must not have earned more than \$25,000 in Reining. Class 5 runs concurrent with class 4. \$25
6. **NOVICE HORSE NON-PRO – LEVEL 1:** Open to Non-Pro (amateur) riders. Horses must not have earned more than \$5,000 in Reining. Class 6 runs concurrent with class 7. \$25
7. **NOVICE HORSE NON-PRO – LEVEL 1:** Open to Non-Pro (amateur) riders. Horses must not have earned more than \$25,000 in Reining. Class 7 runs concurrent with class 6. \$25

BREAKS AND RAKES: Other breaks/rakes will be scheduled based on # of riders in each class and conditions in the arena including judges preference. These will be announced and posted the day of each show.

8. **SNAFFLE BIT / HACKAMORE:** Open to all riders. Horse must be 5 years or younger. \$25
9. **NON-PRO:** Open to any non-professional rider. Must be eligible for a Non-Pro card from NRHA or an amateur card from CSHA or any other National Breed Association. \$25
10. **LIMITED NON-PRO:** Open to any non-pro rider who has not earned \$4,500 in reining classes of any kind. \$25

11. **PRIME TIME NON-PRO:** open to any non-pro rider 50 yrs or older as of January 1, 2012. Must also enter either calls 9 &/or 10. Class 11 runs concurrent with class 9 and/or 10. \$25

BREAKS AND RAKES: Other breaks/rakes will be scheduled based on # of riders in each class and conditions in the arena including judges preference. These will be announced and posted the day of each show.

12. **ROOKIE:** Open to non-pro riders that have not earned \$500 in Reining. Horses to be shown one handed. The Rookie rider/horse combination with the highest combined total score shall win a Trophy Saddle. Must show in all four shows to qualify. \$25
13. **PRIME TIME ROOKIE:** Open to riders 50 yrs and older as of January 1, 2012 who are also eligible for the Rookie class. Must enter class 12. Class 13 runs concurrent with class 12. \$25
14. **YOUTH:** Open to any youth 18 yrs or younger as of January 1, 2012. Youth may not show stallions. Not a Jackpot class. \$15
15. **GREEN REINER:** Open to Non-Pro, Youth, and Amateur riders with less that \$100 lifetime earnings. Youth must have less than 20 NRHA youth points at the beginning of the current show year. Horse to be shown one handed. \$25
16. **GREEN AS GRASS:** Open to Youth, Amateur and Non-Pro riders in their first year of showing. Riders can use two hands with any bit. Not a Jackpot class. \$15

*** There has been some confusion about riding two handed in the classes. ***The only classes where riding two handed is permitted is in Class 8 Snaffle Bit / Hackamore and Class 16 Green As Grass. All other classes must be ridden one handed regardless of bit or age of horse.*** This is per the 2010 NRHA and WCRHA rules.

*** We defer to the NRHA rulebook***
