The CSHA State gymkhana program has not sent out the year-end ratings for the Southern regions as of yet, but since we didn't have any Region 14 members make it to the Northern SOC it doesn't have much effect on us anyway. For now we were advised to use the Sept 2007 rating list.

They have new people in charge of the State program now, so they are working on getting them out to us.

At the last Region meeting, the mem-

bers decided to keep the fees and the year-end requirements the same—at least for now—we will see how our finances fare. The only change made was that for your \$20 raffle donation, they decided that cash is preferred and the raffle committee will then buy nice items for the table. Other items must be approved for raffle table suitability.

Another decision made was that for this year's Benefit Show the proceeds will go to our own arena. Last year we donated to the State program and in lieu of the fact that we have yet to be even acknowledged for doing so, our members decided to keep our money home. The Yucaipa arena committee is always helpful and makes it possible for us to hold our shows here.

Also, a well deserved Thank you to Mr. Weston for making our arena safe, dragging between events for us—it is very much appreciated! Also John Jeffries, thank you for stepping in at the last minute to announce.

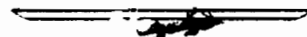

- Be registered in the Region 14 Gymkhana Program (\*see rule 2.7.1 & 2.7.1.1)
- or
- Be a Region 14 "direct" member in Good Standing (\*see rule 2.7.1 & 2.7.1.1)

**To Qualify for 2008 Show of Champions/Region 14 Championship Invitational**

- Be a Region Registered Gymkhana Rider (SOC)
- Attend 5 Sanctioned Shows (not just "rated" shows)
- Place in the Top 10 in your division (point-wise) in the Region
- Be a Region 14 member in good standing (club or direct)
