Definition of Amateur
As defined in the West Coast Horse Show Rulebook

“Every person competing in an amateur class should possess a current amateur card from a recognized equine organization. Basic Definition: Any person who has reached his/her eighteenth birthday and is not a trainer, does not accept pay for showing a horse and/or does not accept prize money for showmanship or equitation. Warning: Management may require proof of amateur status and may deny entry to anyone who cannot furnish said proof. Photocopies are acceptable. Some organizations may require possession of their own amateur card as a prerequisite to competing.

Definition of Amateur
As defined in the CSHA Program Rules, EW, Section 3.1

3.1 Definition of Amateur: Regardless, of one’s equestrian skills and/or accomplishments, a person is an amateur for competition who after his/her 18th birthday has NOT ENGAGED in any of the following activities.

1. Rides, drives, shows in halter, schools, trains or assists in training a horse(s) for remuneration, monetary or otherwise (i.e. free horse boarding, free riding lessons, etc..)
2. Gives instructions in equitation or horse training for remuneration, monetary or otherwise.
3. Accepts prize money in equitation or showmanship classes.
4. Gives instruction to any person or rides, drives, shows in halter in competition or schools for competition or schools for competition any horse(s), for which activity another person in his/her family will receive remuneration, monetary or otherwise, for the activity.
